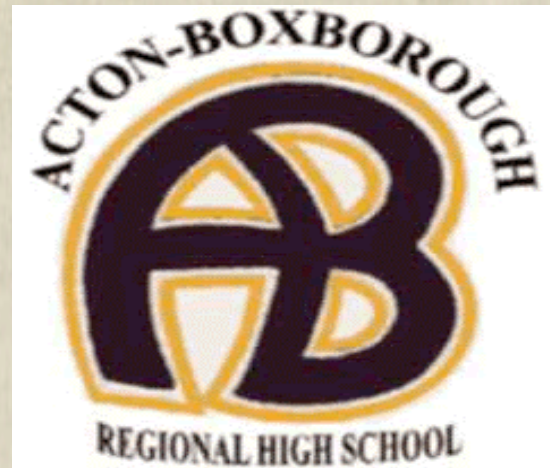


Colonials 9-2!
