

## **TUTORING FOR PAY**

Tutoring is the giving of instruction or assistance to an individual or group for which the teacher receives payment other than through the school districts.

Students are entitled to reasonable assistance both in and outside of class times without charge from their current teachers. In order to avoid placing a teacher in a position where he/she may have a conflict of interest, a teacher, whether full or part-time, shall not be permitted to receive any money for privately tutoring one of his/her current students in an academic subject either on school premises or elsewhere.

If an employee of the Acton Public Schools or the Acton-Boxborough Regional Schools engages in tutoring as defined above, these services may be administered in a school building with administrator approval.

The Superintendent shall establish administrative procedures consistent with this policy.
