

USE OF WEAPONS AS PART OF INSTRUCTION - PROCEDURES

1. If a teacher, with the Principal's consent, determines that a weapon is an essential part of a school lesson, the parent of the student must bring the weapon to the Principal's office where it will be kept until the class or activity in question. An adult will deliver it to the class. The weapon will be returned to the Principal's office where it will be kept until the parent can take it home. The Superintendent must be informed on those occasions when the principal gives such an approval.
2. A professional/amateur performer must receive permission from the Superintendent or designee if any weapons, real or simulated, are to be used in the performance.
