

TITLE 1 FUNDS

Title I funds must be used to supplement the fund that would, in the absence of such title I funds, be made available from non-federal sources for the education of students participating in Title I programs. In no case may Title I funds be used to supplant – take the place of funds from non-federal sources. By adopting this policy, the Acton and Acton-Boxborough School Committees are giving their assurance that the school districts ensure equivalence among their schools in terms of teacher, administrators, and other staff as well as in the provision of curriculum materials and instructional supplies.
