We use our senses to know it is Fall/Winter/Spring.

We could SEE

- Look on the ground, in the trees, in the sky.
- Look for animals, squirrels, chipmunks, birds. What are they doing?
- Do you see any insects? What kinds? What are they doing?
- Different plants: are there any flowers? Grass? Leaves on trees? Anything besides leaves on any of the trees?
- Look for colors: trees, ground, sky
- (winter) Is everything frozen? Are some spots melted?

We could FEEL

*try to get descriptive words
(temperature/texture)

- Feel the ground, grass. How does it feel?
- Sun on face/body?
- Does the ground (grass/sidewalk/asphalt) feel the same in the sun as in the shade?
- How does the air feel? Does it feel the same in the sun and in the shade? Do you need a jacket, mittens, hat?
- How does the ice feel?
- How does the snow feel?

We could SMELL

- Smell the ground, grass.
- Do the leaves have a smell?
- Does the air have a smell?

We could HEAR

*try to get descriptive words

- Listen for birds, wind, leaves
- Where do you hear the sounds? When?
- When you walk, do you make any sounds? (on grass, leaves, ice, snow?)
