

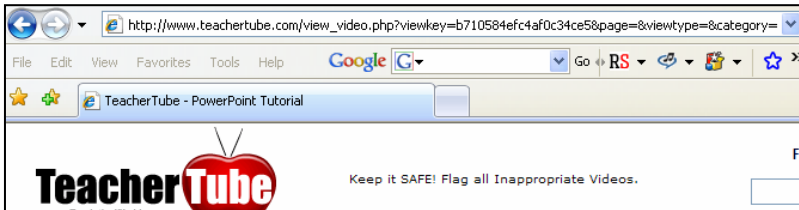


MS PowerPoint: Movie Clips From Internet Links

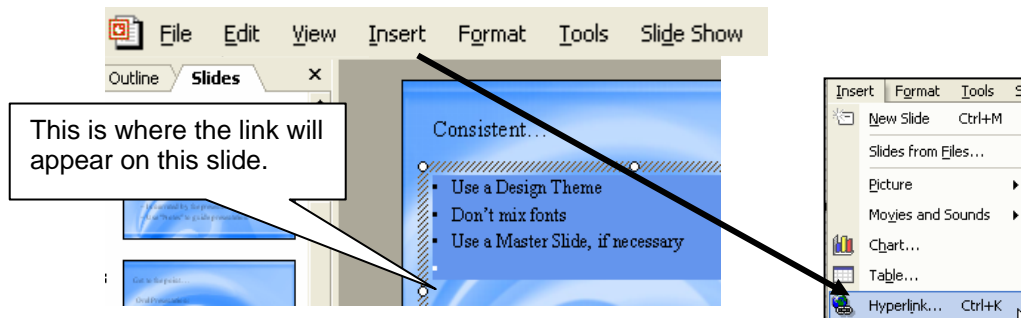
Windows version 2002

Links to movie clips can be inserted in slides. Note: be sure that you have received permission to view clips from the Internet. Remember to check Internet clips to make sure that they are still working before you make your presentation.

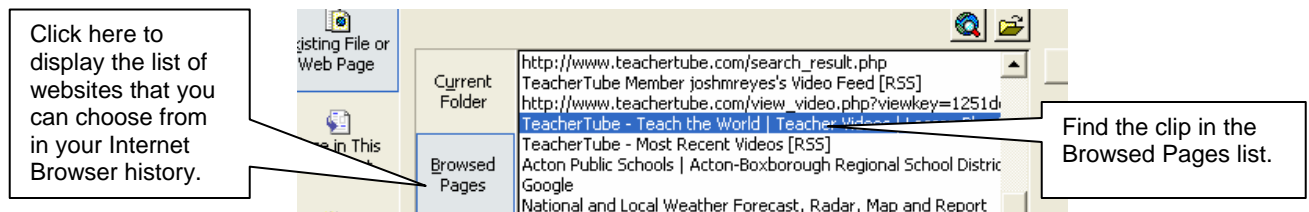
Preview the video clip on the Internet.



Click on the place in your PowerPoint slide where you want to insert the clip, then go to Insert>Hyperlink.

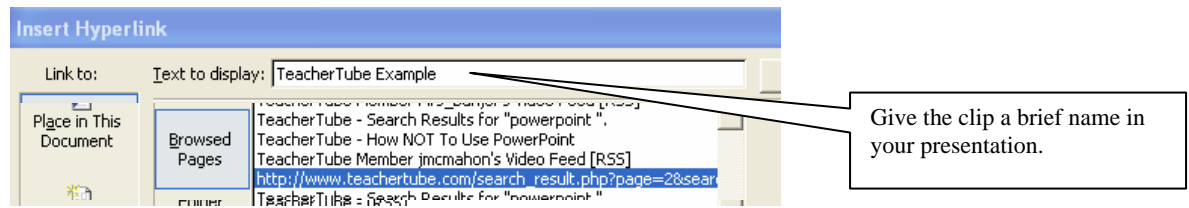


Navigate to Browsed Pages; choose the URL for the clip that you want to insert by clicking on it.

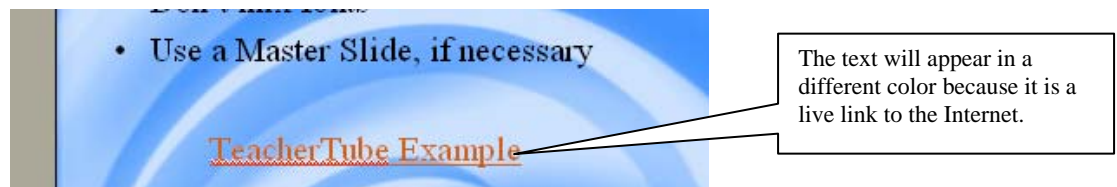


MS PowerPoint: Movie Clips From Internet Links (continued)

Change the “Text to display” to something simple before you click OK, otherwise the URL will appear in your slide.



The “Text to display” appears on your slide. You will click on this link to launch the clip during your presentation.



Note: It's a good idea to launch the movie and allow it to “buffer” on the presentation computer before you attempt to show it during your presentation.
