



## Downloading Photos From your Digital Camera Using iPhoto

MacBook OSX 10.5

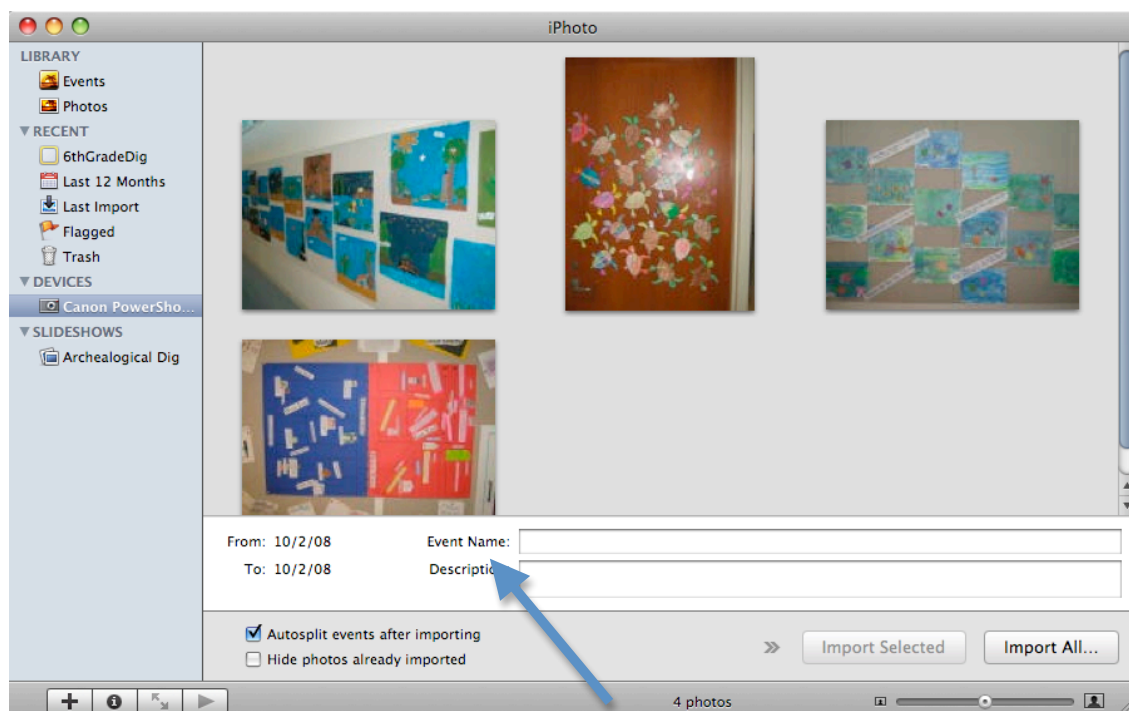
### What you need:

Camera with photos  
USB Connector for camera

### To Download:

1. Open up iPhoto on your computer.
2. Connect your camera using the camera's USB cable to your computer.
3. Turn your camera on.

Your camera should appear below Devices in the iPhoto Source list, located on the left side of the iPhoto window. The pictures in your camera will appear in the viewing area. If nothing happens when you connect your camera, make sure it's turned on and set to the correct setting (i.e.: for viewing photos – not taking photos).



4. Enter your Event name and a description of the photos.

5. Choose which images you would like to import.

If you have already imported some of the photos in your camera, you can select the "Hide photos already imported" checkbox so that you see only the new photos in the Import window.

You can also choose to import only some of the images. To do so, hold down the Command key as you click each photo you want.

To import all your photos, click the Import All button. If you have selected specific photos to import, click the Import Selected button.

6. You will be asked whether you would like to delete originals from the camera – choose yes or no.
7. To view your pictures, click Last Import (in the Source list) or click Events and view your photos by Event.

**To disconnect your camera from your computer:**

1. Drag the camera's icon to the iPhoto Trash.
2. Turn off your camera.
3. Disconnect your camera from your computer.
