I am pleased to announce that the RJG End of Year Activity, scheduled for Thursday, June 17, 2004, will be a school wide trip to Canobie Lake Park. We will ride to the park in coach busses and will depart from RJ Grey at 9:00 a.m.. This will allow us to arrive at the park around 10:00 a.m. when the gates open. We will depart from Canobie Lake at 2:30 and will be back at RJ Grey by 3:30. The school buses will be available to transport RJ Grey students home on their regular routes.

Our plan is to have one chaperone for every group of 10-12 students. These students will be required to do a MANDATORY check in with their assigned adult between 11:45-12:15 at a designated location. Each student must **personally check him/herself in with the adult**. In addition, we will require that when **students go to the restroom facilities, they must be with a buddy**. We will recommend that students stay with a buddy or small group, although this will **not be mandatory**. Students will be permitted to go on rides or wait in lines without a buddy.

The cost per student will be \$25.00. This includes transportation and an all day pass for the amusement park at Canobie Lake. Students will need additional money if they wish to buy lunch, snacks or other personal items. We at RJ Grey want to ensure that each student has the opportunity to participate in all school sponsored events and activities. Please contact your child's teacher, counselor or a school administrator to discuss a waiver, financial assistance or a scholarship if you are in a difficult financial situation at this time.
