

How to Study for a Math Test or Quiz

Suggestions from Ms. Kelly

1. Get out any **quizzes** from that chapter.
 - a) Re-do all the problems you got wrong.
 - b) Be sure you still know how to do all the other problems and try any that might cause you difficulty now.

2. Turn to all your **homeworks from the book** for that chapter.
 - a) Re-do all the problems you got wrong or got help.
 - b) Be sure you still know how to do all the other problems and try any that might cause you difficulty now.

3. Turn to all the **worksheets** for that chapter.
 - a) Re-do all the problems you got wrong.
 - b) Be sure you still know how to do all the other problems and try any that might cause you difficulty now.

4. Turn to your **notes** from that chapter.
 - a) Highlight any terms you should know. Then explain the meaning of those terms to someone else, or say them out loud, or write them down.
 - b) Be sure you know how to do all the examples.

If you still have time ...

5. Open your book to the start of the chapter.
 - a) Skim each lesson identifying the terms you should know.
 - b) Do the examples from each lesson in the book.
 - c) Try any odd problems not assigned and correct them using the back of the book.
