Dear Parent,

We hope that your child has had a smooth transition to the 2009-10 school year. At this time we have met with all seventh and eighth graders who have been assigned to the Academic Support Center (ASC), a regular education program that provides students with additional academic support during the school day. The majority of our students attend the ASC during Grey Block or an Exploratory class.

In the ASC, assistance is given in strategies for organization, test/quiz preparation, following written directions and tracking homework assignments. We are prepared to get students started with homework; but homework should never be saved for the ASC on the day it is due. Students, selected on the basis of academic need, receive additional reading and math support apart from what is expected on his/her team.

If your child attends the ASC during a scheduled T we look forward to seeing you on *Back to School Night* on September 30th; however, if your child's schedule does not reflect an ASC slot, please make every effort to come by and learn about the program. **We are located in Room 312.**
