Expectations:

X-Block Rehearsals: To participate fully and productively in band a student must arrive prepared. Please be sure to bring your well-oiled and maintained instrument to class each rehearsal. Be sure to keep your music in your folder and have it with you in each class. Be sure to **BRING A PENCIL** to each class to mark the music as we rehearse it. This will enable us to work productively together each day!

Practice: Playing a musical instrument is hard work. Though I do not expect students to practice two hours every day, I do expect that they will commit some effort to practice of their instrument. 15-20 every other day, not including set-up or breakdown of instrument, would go a long way in helping a student to learn to play their instrument and music satisfactorily. Doing more than this would be GREAT!

Behavior: Playing in a band is a very cool thing. We have an opportunity to learn to work together as a team and grow musically together. This requires that each person involved make a commitment to work hard and work cooperatively. Being polite and responsive is key between both peers and teachers. To make this a truly positive experience a good attitude in rehearsal will go a long way to making band fun and productive.

Attendance: Band is a scheduled class and needs to be treated as such. It is not fair to your peers to miss rehearsal because you need to finish a project for another class. So, please make every effort to be at class and to be on time!

Performances: The band's performances are like final exams! We have worked all semester long to attain a strong performance level as a group and need to make our presentation as a group! Please plan ahead and make every effort to attend our performances.
