- Summary -

The R.J. Grey School Council met on Tuesday, October 10, 2006 at 7:00 p.m. in the school library. Members in attendance were Principal Craig Hardimon, 7<sup>th</sup> grade teacher Jeanne Goulet and parent representatives Lisa Gundlach, Karyn Finamore and John Murray.
